Dear Governor Brown:

On behalf of AMERICA'S EDGE, a nonprofit organization including more than 50 business leaders in California committed to strengthening American businesses and our state's economy through proven investments in children and youth, we write in **support of SB 612 (Steinberg)** to help more high school students develop the skills and knowledge they'll need to graduate from high school prepared for success in college and career.

Senate Bill 612 would expand a proven teacher professional development program – the California Subject Matter Projects – to meet the needs of the new economy by including professional development that prepares teachers to deliver hands-on, integrated curriculum, such as that developed by the UCCI Institute, which is connected to high-need sectors of the economy.

California's public systems of education have a significant opportunity to contribute to the state's job growth and economic recovery by aligning high school curricula more closely to the needs of growing and emerging areas of our economy. But we must increase the number of students graduating from high school ready to succeed in college and a workplace that is far more complicated and demanding than it was even a decade ago.
